Video: Students are invited to prepare a short video with attention paid at technical skills, story telling and overall execution. Please see Mr Clark for more details .

- Middle and Senior School Time Limit: 3 minutes

Writing: Students are invited to submit a piece of writing with attention paid to creative writing skills, critical thinking, syntax and descriptive language. An editing session will occur at lunchtime prior to the Final Entry date. Please see Ms Hickey for more details.

- Middle and Senior School Word Limit: 500 – 800 words
- Junior School Work Limit: 300 - 500 words

Photography: Students are invited to submit an image that captures shadows on camera with attention paid to use of shade – it can be figurative or abstract in nature. Please see Ms Westcott for more details.

The House Creative Arts Competitions are competitions of skill; chance plays no part in determining the winners. Entries will be judged based on creative merit, technical skills, uniqueness and inspirational qualities by a panel of judges. Originality and adherence to the theme of ‘Shadows’ and The judges’ decision is final and binding, and no correspondence will be entered into.
